Make stops in Canyon to explore the geology

10:00 - Stop at campground just before the dam to see thrusts and rocks

1:00 - Stop at Wind River Lake for view and discussion of the Absaroka volcanics

2:30 – Arrive back in Jackson

Day 1 Friday June 26

LEGEND ROCK PETROGLYPH SITE

This protected site is approximately 23 miles west of Thermopolis contains at least 283 different petroglyphs on 92 individual sandstone "panels." It must be seen to be believed!

To get to the site take Hwy. 120 from Thermopolis toward Meeteetse for 21 miles. Turn left at the second Hamilton Dome turn-off (Cottonwood Creek Road) and drive west about five miles. Once you arrive at a crossroads, you will continue west on Cottonwood Creek Road until you reach the second of two cattle guards. Turn left immediately after the second cattle guard. Follow that road until you reach a fork in the road. Stay to the left and the road will lead to a gate. Field trip leaders will have the key for entry.


In the morning we can look for Cyanbacteria in outflow of the hotsprings or go to Ava's Rock Shop where samples of local rocks are displayed outside.




Day 3 Sunday June 28th


Tour the Wind River Canyon
