

“Outcrop of the Month” outing for Members - 31 July, 4-7 pm

Walk to the top of Snow King Mtn and explore the geology of Jackson Hole with Patrick Starich and John Hebberger (Jr.)!

Meet at the “Wildlife Lane” parking area & trail head along Snow King Avenue (where it crosses Flat Creek) at 4 pm. You do not need to sign up, just be there by 4 pm.

Considerations:

- ~1100' elevation gain
- ~1.5 miles each way
- Need walking shoes, hat, wind breaker, water, snack (?), sunscreen, hiking poles if you use them.
- Please do **NOT** come if you realistically can not readily do this hike!
- We will cancel only for rain.



We will consider the geology that makes up Snow King Mtn , as well as the much more regional geology visible from atop the mountain which - causes Jackson Hole & the Teton Range to exist
